Use : spray cleaning (cleaners) : Wash floors, taking up dust (wipe damp). Wetrok 2care-apply solution sparingly by spraying and work in immediately with the polishing machine (spray pad). Turn pad over or exchange in good time (as soon as it is full of dirt).

scrub-extraction :

Fill fresh water tank with Wetrok 2care solution. Attach a suitable pad / brush.

Clean floor coverings thoroughly.

Protective treatment :

Clean floor covering thoroughly. The floor must be clean, free from old coatings and dry, before treatment. Wetrok 2care apply in sections and spread evenly using the applicator. 2 - 3 thin application . Allow to dry for approx 60 minutes between coats. Polish with soft pad when completely hard (2-3 days), if necessary.
